Admissions Application Process:

- Completed Graduate application and Residency form
- \$50.00 non-refundable application fee.
- One official transcript from each college you have attended.

In addition, for a complete application, please send the following directly to the Nutrition/Dietetics Department at the address given below:

- A letter of intent describing your background, interests, objectives, and how the degree fits in your plans. You can address your letter to: Dr. Carole Conn, Graduate Coordinator, Nutrition/Dietetics Program.
- One official transcript from each college you have attended. **This is in addition to the one that goes to the Office of Admissions**
- A current resume
- GRE scores
