Format Length

Articles/Essays/Interviews	5,000 to 7,000 excluding references, tables, figures and abstract (approximately 100 words)
Poetry	500 – 700 words
Book and Media Reviews	3,000 words, excluding references
Audio/Video	15 minutes maximum
